## Services Provided:

- Basic Needs Assessment / Intake with Information and Referral
- Comprehensive Case Management
- Family Check Up (Evidence- Based Program)
- Everyday Parenting (Evidence- Based Program)
- Familias Unidas
- Connections to Family and Human Services (Incredible Years, Strengthening Families, FFT)
- Ongoing support and connections to further services, help with LIHEAP / Financial applications, etc

Current Goal via OCDEL grant funding: to provide 100 families with connections with community resources and 100 families with the evidence-based program Family Check Up and Everyday Parent annually.

Funding will be \$788,000 each year for 3-5 years. Total award: \$3.9M

## Respective Solutions Group Center For Families

The Respective Solutions Group (RSG) Center For Families will conduct intake services that will provide comprehensive case management and information and referral services to families. This means that our team will stay with families from the first phone call or visit through all their needs. We are here for the long haul to help build connections, support growth, and inspire the strength of each family engaged in services. These services will work to help families with basic needs, mental health services, and parenting education / family supports. The family center will also provide comprehensive case management for all families from intake. Support provided by the Center For Families can be ongoing as families work to gain skills and access services. RSG Center For Families will be available to all families in Adams County and services will be provided in both English and Spanish.

## Family Check Up

Family Check Up is an evidence-based program that has been found to be well supported by the Title IV-E Prevention Service Clearinghouse. It was found to be favorable in the areas of adult well-being and positive parenting practices. Family Check Up is for families with kids aged 2 through 17. Family Check Up is a three to four session assessment of parenting skills and parenting needs conducted with a family and clinical team. After that assessment process is complete the family can be referred to Everyday Parenting to help them increase any skills or needs the family may want assistance. Also, a family may choose to engage with another program or service recommended in the process. Our Center For Families team will work in partnership with families, empowering their voice and decisions in connecting to supports that lead to success. All services are available in Spanish and English.

This program is a qualifying program under the Families First initiative.



## Everyday Parenting

Everyday Parenting provides parenting strategies and helps to increase families' positive daily interactions. Everyday Parenting provides a menu of parenting skills and needs that can be tailored to each individual family. Everyday Parenting is available to families with kids ages 2 through 17. Everyday Parenting can be completed in a schedule that works best for the family. The program covers a wide range of skills from positive routines to communication skills. What lessons are completed in Everyday Parenting is determined by the assessments completed in Family Check Up and by expressed needs of the families. Everyday Parenting will be provided in English and Spanish.

This program is a qualifying program under the Families First initiative.

## Familias Unidas - Services Provided:

The Familias Unidas (Evidence-Based Program) provides a culturally appropriate and representative supports to LatinX families to help increase family functioning, increase parental monitoring, and decrease unsafe sexual and drug use behaviors. Program goals include service to 24 youth and 32 caregivers in 22-23 and 60 youth and 79 caregivers in 23-24. The program will be a 14-week cohort with 3 to 4 individual sessions. Title IV-E Prevention Service Clearinghouse Services found the program to be well supported, showing favorable impacts in child well-being: behavioral and emotional functioning, child well-being: substance use, adult well-being: positive parenting practices, and adult well-being: family functioning. Program will be provided Spanish.

This program is a qualifying program under the Families First initiative.
